

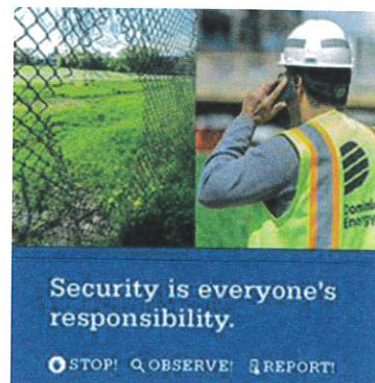

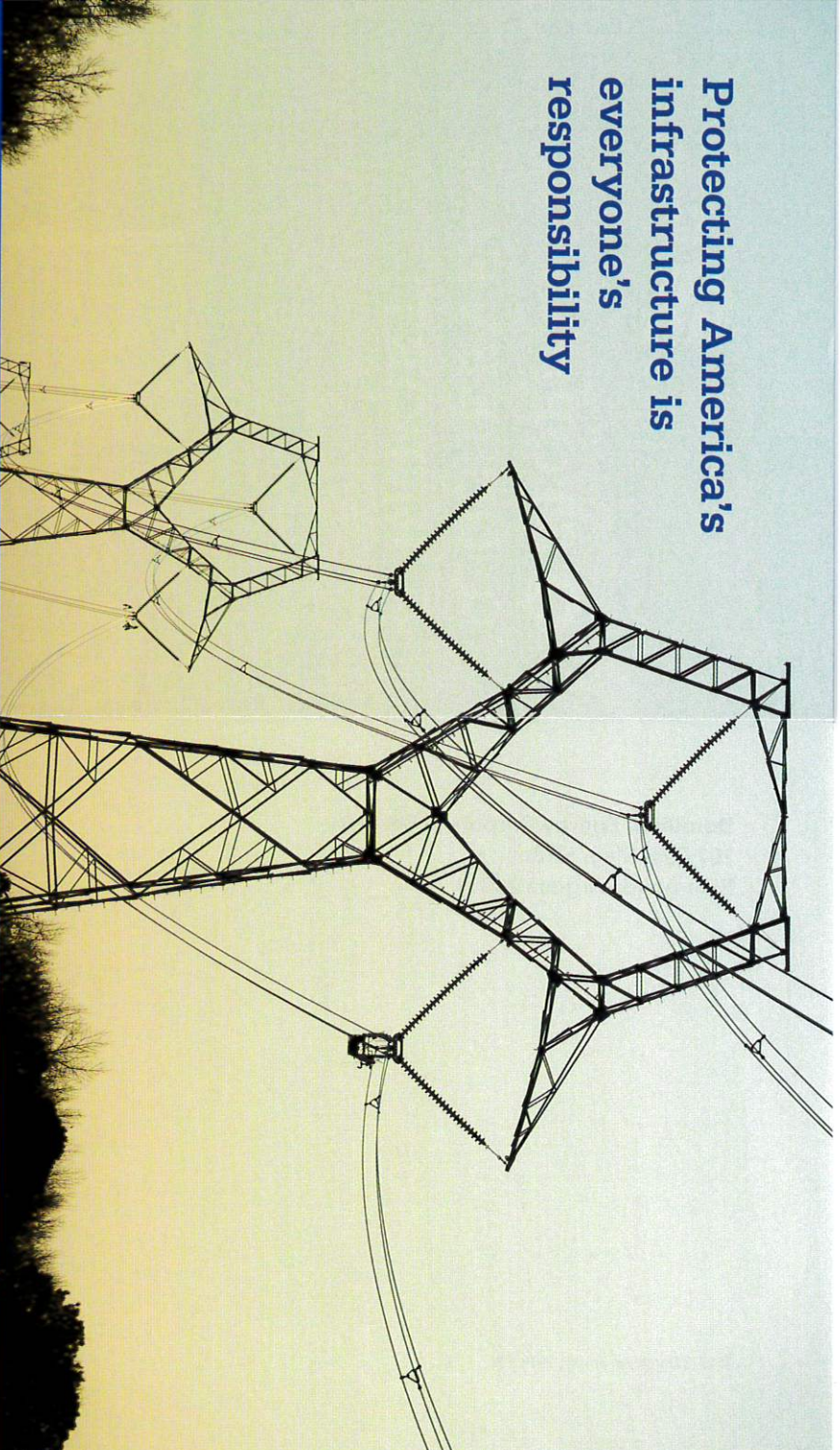

The production, transmission and delivery of natural gas and electricity requires locating transmission lines, pipelines, substations and other critical facilities throughout a vast geographical region.

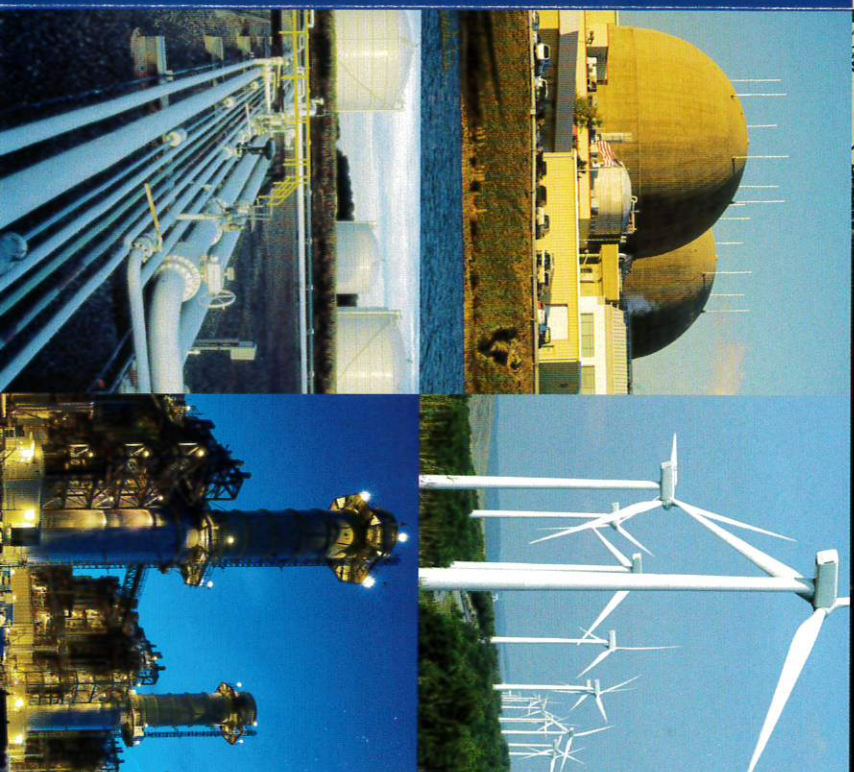
These facilities are important to the American economy and our everyday lives, and we take security responsibilities for them very seriously.

Signs of Terrorism

Surveillance

Recording or monitoring activities, drawing diagrams or annotating on maps, in possession of a Dominion Energy facility blueprint, etc.

Information Gathering

Trying to gain information or knowledge about a Dominion Energy facility or the people who work there

Testing Security

Watching to see how long it takes emergency responders to get to a scene; measuring reaction time

Planning/Acquiring Supplies

Purchase or theft of explosives, weapons, or ammunition; also storage of harmful chemicals or equipment

Suspicious People Who Don't Belong

People who don't seem to belong in the workplace, neighborhood, business establishment, or who demonstrate odd behavior

Rehearsal/Dry Run

Practice session run before final operation or plan; monitoring police radio frequency or recording emergency response times; mapping routes and traffic flow

Deploying Assets/Getting Into Position

People and supplies getting into position to commit the final action. This is the last chance to alert Dominion Energy Corporate Security or law enforcement before terrorist act occurs.

Report any unusual signs to Dominion Energy Corporate Security, no matter how insignificant they might appear to be, since indicators may come months or even years before an incident occurs.
