Mrs. Wax Carr explained, as a companion to the last piece of legislation read in there is a public hearing. She said the gentleman from NOPEC was not there yet but she

felt that her and the Mayor could answer any questions. She reminded them that Brenda Fargo was at the last meeting to explain. Mrs. Wax Carr briefly explained the three pieces of legislation and why the City liked this program.
