## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2017 MTECH STREET SWEEPER FROM JOHNSTON, NORTH AMERICA FOR USE BY THE CITY'S SERVICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City is in need of a second street sweeper to maintain its streets; and

WHEREAS, the City authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2017 MTECH Street Sweeper from Johnston, North America pursuant to pricing through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

## **SCTION ONE:**

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement with Johnston, North America pursuant to pricing under the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, for the purchase of one (1) 2017 MTECH Street Sweeper, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred and Forty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Six Dollars and No Cents (\$249,756.00), as is more fully set forth in the quotation attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

#### **SECTION TWO:**

The requirement for competitive bidding is waived pursuant to Section 210.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Green. This purchase is being made in accordance with the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program under Contract No. 800289/ STS 235 and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

#### **SECTION THREE:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

#### **SECTION FOUR:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that the need for this equipment is immediate. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
