A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE FOR FIRE DISPATCH SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green ("Green") and the Village of Lakemore ("Lakemore") desire to enter into an agreement for Green to provide emergency fire and medical dispatching services on a twenty-four hour, seven days per week basis, from Green Fire Station #1; and

WHEREAS, this agreement will permit Green and Lakemore to realize a mutual benefit from participating in a regional dispatch operation and to implement their developed policies, procedures and protocols for standardizing emergency scene operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:


Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Village of Lakemore for Fire Dispatch Services in a form substantially similar to that attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A".


SECTION TWO:


The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason to ensure that there is no interruption to the dispatching services provided by Green to Lakemore. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
