




WHERE HAVE WE BEEN?



Since 2011, attendance at the Akron Zoo has grown over 14.7%.



Since receiving public funding in 2001 attendance grew from 114,139 to 402,143. 40% of our guests are from Summit County 60% reside in surrounding counties and states

RETURN ON INVESTMENT



The Akron Zoo has generated nearly \$8 in impact for every \$1 of levy support received since 2011.

(\$66.9 million invested, \$506 million returned)

ECONOMIC IMPACT

Since 2011, the number of jobs supported throughout Summit County has grown by nearly 40% to over 850 full time equivalents.

Since 2011, the Akron Zoo has had an overall economic impact of over \$506 million across Summit County.


ECONOMIC ACTIVITY SINCE 2011

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES



Akron Zoo is a leader in providing STEM focused education opportunities for school age children.

In 2019, the Akron Zoo...

- Served 81 school districts in Northeast Ohio.
- Welcomed 35,404 school children for class field trips.
- Provided 131 on grounds programs to over 6,420 people.
- Reached over 44,850 individuals through outreach programming.



SAVING SPECIES



A RESPONSIBLE STEWARD

With levy funding, the zoo has been able to create new habitats.

Now, 250 species and over 1,000 animals call the Akron Zoo home.





NOVEMBER 2020

The Akron Zoo will be on the November 3, 2020 ballot requesting a 0.8 mil renewal levy and 0.4 mil increase. This request will be \$2.92 per month for the owner of a \$100,000 home.

This is the first time since our original levy passed 20 years ago that the zoo is asking for an increase.

Ticket Distribution in 2020

Your community will have 14 days to choose from during the two week time period. Tickets will be available two weeks in advance of your community's first visit date.

During the two weeks your free tickets are available, residents will be able to get up to four free tickets by going to the zoo's website: www.akronzoo.org.

A Summit County Community Days page will be on the zoo's website with step by step instructions on how Summit County residents can secure free tickets. We do have to limit the number of tickets available each day to prevent overcrowding and allow for social distancing.
