

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT TO POLICING CONTRACT

This Supplemental Agreement ("Agreement") is made this ___ day of _____ 2025, by and between the CITY OF GREEN ("Green"), the COUNTY OF SUMMIT ("County") and the SHERIFF OF SUMMIT COUNTY ("Sheriff").

1. Agreement. Green, County, and Sheriff entered into a Policing Contract for the term commencing January 1, 2024 and ending December 31, 2026.

As part of the negotiations for the new Policing Contract, the parties investigated various ways to reduce the cost of providing policing services to Green. The parties have agreed to an annual reduction/credit to the Policing Contract based upon the services, facilities and equipment provided by Green to County and Sheriff.

2. Policing Contract Credits. Green, County, and Sheriff agree to the following annual credits increasing 3% annually and applied to the Policing Contract credits:

a. Garage space with utilities	\$5.00 annual rent	\$21,854.54
(393 E. Turkeyfoot Lake Road)		
b. Tower electric		\$ 7,457.86
c. Tactical medics/equipment		\$ 5,627.54
TOTAL		\$34,939.94

Green will receive the credit by reducing the January payment due each year under the Policing Contract for the period of January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2026, by the amount of the credit, which will be increased 3% each year thereafter as follows:

2024 Credit	\$34,939.94	(\$34,939.94)
2025 Credit	\$35,988.14	(\$34,939.94 X 1.03)
2026 Credit	\$37,067.78	(\$35,988.14 X 1.03)

3. Authority. The parties executing this agreement on behalf of Green, County, and Sheriff have the authority and received all the necessary approvals to execute and bind Green, County, and Sheriff to the terms of this Agreement.
4. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between and among the parties. This Agreement can only be amended or modified by a written document executed by all parties.

7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a supplemental policing contract for the**
8 **Sheriff's Office, with the City of Green, for use of space, utilities and equipment, for the**
9 **period 1/1/2024 through 12/31/2026, for the Executive and the Sheriff, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2023-313, a policing contract was executed
13 between the Executive, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office and the City of Green for the calendar
14 years 2024, 2025 and 2026; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Green has in prior years been given a credit for the Sheriff's
17 Office use of garage space, a tower and equipment; and

18
19 WHEREAS, attached hereto as Exhibit A is a copy of the supplemental policing
20 agreement to the previously executed policing contract to account for the use of the above-
21 referenced items which will be a credit of \$34,939.94 for 2024, a credit up to \$35,988.14 for
22 2025 and a credit up to \$37,067.78 for 2026, for a total amount not to exceed \$107,995.86; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
26 execute the aforementioned supplemental policing contract for credits to the City of Green for
27 calendar years 2024, 2025 and 2026, for use of the above-referenced items in conjunction with
28 the previously executed policing contract;

30 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that:

33 SECTION 1

35 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute the supplemental policing contract with
36 the City of Green, in substantially the same form as Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached to this
37 Resolution and incorporated as if written, for a total amount not to exceed \$107,995.36, for
38 calendar years 2024, 2025 and 2026, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in
39 furtherance of the provisions of said agreement and not substantially adverse to the
40 County, and any necessary related documents.

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42 SECTION 2

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44 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
45 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
46 authorize various fees to be credited by the Sheriff and to authorize the Executive to execute said
47 supplemental policing contract so the Sheriff may access said items.
