INTRODUCED: JANUARY 14, 2025 ASSIGNED TO:

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE POSITION OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, ESTABLISHING A RATE OF COMPENSATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green submitted legislation in 2010 to create the position of Deputy Director of Public Service which was subsequently defeated by Green City Council; and

WHEREAS, through an administrative error, the position of Deputy Service Director was filled and has been budgeted with an established pay range and a functioning paid position within the city since 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green continues to have a need for the position of Deputy Director of Public Service to support the Mayor and Director of Public Service in managing the Service Department operations; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to officially create the position of Deputy Director of Public Service to reflect current city staffing, and establish a rate of compensation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council establishes the position of Deputy Director of Public Service, as described in Exhibit A. The position of Deputy Director of Public Service is established as pay grade 13 with a minimum of \$40.94 per hour (\$85,155 annualized) and a maximum of \$61.41 per hour (\$127,733 annualized).

SECTION TWO:

The Deputy Director of Public Service will be non-bargaining, FLSA exempt, and unclassified and exempt from Civil Service Rules and Regulations.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall

take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
