

Subject: Cell Charging Station – Resolution 2021-R06

In December 2020, we received notification that a community cell charging station was available from NOPEC. We had been on a waiting list. We sent a letter of intent that we would accept the cell charging station upon City Council approval. Before you currently is 2021-R06 which accepts the cell charging agreement.

We will be locating the cell charger seasonally at the Splash Pad then relocating off season for use either at the community hall or CAB. <u>Enclosed</u> please find an illustration of the charging station. The newer version station also has a UV feature that disinfects the phone as it is charging.

If there are no objections, I would <u>request second reading passage at the Feb 9th meeting</u>, <u>since we have</u> given them a letter of intent and so that we assure getting the unit before summer.



Bay Secured Locker Style Station

This station can charge all types of phones and tablets and is easy to move with lockable casters. Each locker bay locks and keeps contents safe. Users will receive a temporary lock code when using the station.
