A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GREEN AND SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, THROUGH THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION OF THE CITY OF GREEN'S EMERGENCY AND MINOR HOME REPAIR PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since 2006, the City of Green has contracted with Rebuilding Together Summit County to assist with its emergency and minor home repair program for low income families; and

WHEREAS, with this partnership, the program has successfully helped residents over the last eleven (11) years; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to also partner with Summit County, Ohio, through the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, to further assist the City with its emergency and minor home repair program; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into this partnership, effective January 1, 2018, for said purposes which will allow the City to leverage Summit County CDBG and other available funds to assist in the repairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council approves an Agreement between the City of Green and Summit County, Ohio, through the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, for the administration and operation of the City of Green's emergency and minor home repair program. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that program may continue uninterrupted. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
