WHEREAS, in promotion of the public interest of the residents of the City, it is necessary for the City to appropriate for street purposes certain fee simple interests and easements in and to various premises to facilitate the construction and installation of a roundabout, altogether with the necessary appurtenances thereto further identified as the SR 619/Pickle Road Roundabout Project; and

SECTION ONE:
