A RESOLUTION CREATING THE POSITION OF PARKS PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATOR, ESTABLISHING A RATE OF COMPENSATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green recognizes the vast amount of park lands the City has acquired over the years and realizes the need for a position specifically responsible for the planning, budgeting, and community relations involving the park areas; and

WHEREAS, the Administration deems it necessary to create the position of Parks Planning & Development Administrator to differentiate the position and duties from the previous Parks and Recreation Superintendent position; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a rate of compensation for the position of Parks Planning & Development Administrator; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to determine the classification of the position under the Civil Service Rules and Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council hereby establishes the position of Parks Planning & Development Administrator as of August 13, 2019.

SECTION TWO:

The position of Parks Planning & Development Administrator will be at a paygrade 11 under the current salary range. The position of Parks Planning & Development Administrator will be a Fair Labor Standard Act exempt position and is classified position under the Civil Service Rules and Regulations.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take

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effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
