A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO UNITED EARTHWORKS, LLC FOR THE GRAYBILL ROAD CULVERT AND DITCHING IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, April 18, 2019; and, Thursday, April 25, 2019, for the Graybill Road Culvert and Ditching Improvements Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on Friday, May 3, 2019, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the Contract be awarded to United Earthworks, LLC as the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Dollars and Forty-Seven Cents (\$100,870.47).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with United Earthworks, LLC for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to United Earthworks, LLC through the established purchase order procedure.

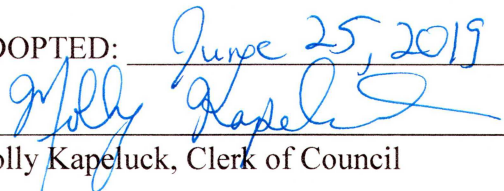
SECTION FOUR:

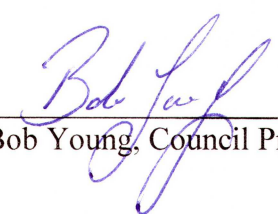

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the Project may proceed immediately and forthwith. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
