A RESOLUTION RATIFYING A THREE-YEAR LABOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GREEN AND LOCAL 2714 OF THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES ("AFSCME") DISPATCH UNIT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the previous Labor Agreement between the City of Green and AFSCME Local 2714 Dispatch Unit expired on April 15, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the negotiating teams for the City of Green and AFSCME Local 2714 have reached a tentative three (3) year Labor Agreement for the Dispatch Unit; and

WHEREAS, Green City Council desires to ratify the three (3) year Labor Agreement by and between the City of Green and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Local 2714 Dispatch Unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council ratifies the three (3) year Labor Agreement between the City of Green and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Local 2714 Dispatch Unit for the period of April 16, 2019 through April 15, 2022.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes and directs all necessary officials to execute the terms of the Labor Agreement.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council authorizes and directs the Finance Director to make all payments necessary to effectuate the terms of the Labor Agreement.

SECTION FOUR:

The terms and conditions of the collective bargaining agreement sets forth the wages, hours and working conditions of bargaining unit employees and supersedes all legislation of the City addressing any wages and benefits for such employees.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

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SECTION SIX:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason so that the same is authorized within the necessary time periods required by the Ohio Revised Code. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
