**Subject:** Dirt bike noise

Hello,

My name is Adam Lee and I live at [3058 Stonehurst road](#) here in the Lakes of Green. I called the city zoning office hoping to find out how we could resolve a noise problem we've been having in our neighborhood. They basically told us that wasn't their job to deal with, and didn't offer much assistance in where to turn.

We have some people who live behind the neighborhood who ride dirt bikes ALL THE TIME. It usually starts about [4:00pm](#) after school and will go, on and off until dusk and sometimes after dark. It happens almost every day that the weather is decent. The noise level is hard to describe but it echoes throughout the entire neighborhood and is LOUD. There's literally nowhere I can go in my house and not hear the noise even with all the windows shut. No one is able to enjoy any outdoor space pretty much any evening as you can't even have a conversation outside without yelling over a dirt bike. Again this is an almost every day/evening occurrence in the middle of a residential area. They are not in the lakes of green, but are not on a farm or in the woods occasionally passing by the neighborhood. They are just circling their back yard over and over.

Several people from our neighborhood have tried to talk to them but they are very confrontational about the situation. They basically are just going out of their way to be as obnoxious as possible at this point. Several of us have called the summit county sheriff's office and we're told there's nothing they can do, as they are not technically breaking any laws. So I called the main city of green phone number listed on the website and we were told to call the zoning department. The zoning department told us to call the sherriff's office which does no good. So we are stuck in a circle of phone calls. We called the main city number again and they recommended contacting city council. We're hoping someone can lead us to a solution, because it is getting very frustrating to rarely have a peaceful evening.
