A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DURA MARK, INC. FOR THE 2017 AUXILIARY PAVEMENT MARKING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” in the Akron Beacon Journal on Wednesday, July 26, 2017; and, Wednesday, August 2, 2017, for the 2017 Auxiliary Pavement Marking (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, on Thursday, August 10, 2017, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Dura Mark, Inc. as the lowest and best bidder for the Project in the amount of \$128,371.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on August 10, 2017:

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, Dura Mark, Inc. is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications. The City Engineer has recommended awarding the base bid to Dura Mark, Inc. in the amount of \$128,371.15.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Dura Mark, Inc. for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Dura Mark, Inc. through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
