AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 660.14, “OFFENSIVE WEEDS AND GRASS” OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GREEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Zoning Division has reviewed the existing ordinance in regard to offensive weeds and grass within the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Division has recommended that Section 660.14 be amended to provide the clarity and uniformity in the enforcement of the weeds and grass control within the City of Green.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Existing Section 660.14 of Green’s Codified Ordinances be, and the same is hereby amended to read and provide, in its entirety, as it is set forth in Exhibit “A”, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by referenced.

SECTION TWO:

Any other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed to the extent of a conflict and all ordinances not amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

City Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that enforcement may go into effect as soon as possible. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
