A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO PROVIDE STABLES FOR THE HORSES OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY SHERIFF'S MOUNTED PATROL UNIT, FOR A FIVE YEAR TERM COMMENCING JUNE 1, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since 2006 the City has provided the County the ability to lease the barn located at Southgate Farm for the purpose of providing stables for the horses of the Summit County Sheriff's Mounted Patrol Unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green requires Summit County for and on behalf of the Summit County Sheriff's Office to enter into a new five year (5) Lease Agreement commencing as of June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2022, with the option to renew for one (1) additional five (5) year term, for consideration in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00); and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizes the City of Green to enter into the aforementioned Lease Agreement that it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Green.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council is hereby authorized to enter into a Lease Agreement with Summit County, Ohio for and on behalf of the Summit County Sheriff's Office for the purpose of providing stables for the horses of the Summit County Sheriff's Mounted Patrol Unit, for consideration in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00), for a term of five (5) years. A copy of the Lease Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the lease may be effective immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect

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and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
