A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GREEN AND REBUILDING TOGETHER SUMMIT COUNTY, NOW KNOWN AS REBUILDING TOGETHER NORTHEAST OHIO, FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION OF THE CITY OF GREEN'S EMERGENCY AND MINOR HOME REPAIR PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green originally contracted with Rebuilding Together Summit County in 2006 and again in 2011 for an emergency and minor home repair program for low income families; and

WHEREAS, the program has successfully helped several residents over the last eleven (11) years; and

WHEREAS, the City and representatives of Rebuilding Together Northeast Ohio have discussed an amendment to the agreement which allows for an increase in Rebuilding Together's reimbursement for administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, the City and Rebuilding Together desire to provide for a twenty percent (20%) administrative fee on all home repair programs performed in the City of Green in an amount not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per individual project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council approves the First Amendment to the Agreement between the City of Green and Rebuilding Together Northeast Ohio for the administration and operation of the City of Green's emergency and minor home repair program. A copy of the First Amendment to the Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that pending projects may process as soon as possible. The City needs to begin purchasing the needed materials immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon

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its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
