A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO EXTEND ITS AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL SERVICES WITH ORIANA HOUSE, INC.

WHEREAS, as a municipality, the City of Green is required to pay for work release programs, halfway house programs, and home incarceration programs for criminal defendants charged and convicted of violating City of Green municipal ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Oriana House, Inc. is an organization duly authorized to provide work release program services, halfway house services, and home incarceration services to charged and convicted defendants; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously contracted with Oriana House, Inc. for these services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Green to extend its agreement with Oriana House, Inc. for the purposes set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to continue under the same terms the City of Green and Oriana House, Inc have been operating under the last Agreement which ran between January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2017. The Agreement is to Provide Community Correctional Services with Oriana House, Inc. (“Agreement”) for the purpose of providing incarceration services for criminal defendants charged and convicted of violations of City of Green municipal ordinances for the time period from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payments to Oriana House, Inc. in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that services

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are currently being provided. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
