A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ACCEPT THE 2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR ADA RENOVATIONS AT THE TOROK COMMUNITY & SENIOR CENTER, AUTHORIZING THE MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green adopted Resolution 2018-R53 authorizing the Mayor to execute and accept the Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) Funds for the Lichtenwalter Schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, the Grantor of the CDBG, County of Summit, Ohio, has amended the grant award, referenced in Resolution 2018-R53, to be utilized for updating the Torok Community & Senior Center with ADA renovations instead of the Litchenwalter Schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, the grant has been awarded to the City of Green in the total amount of Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the matching local share for the City of Green is Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City will use the Grant for ADA compliant doors and ramps, concrete patio and sidewalk repairs, as well as, roof updates at the Torok Community & Senior Center, not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Green accepts the Grant in accordance with the Agreement terms, a copy of which is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes and directs the Mayor to accept the 2018 CDBG Funds in the amount of Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00). The City’s matching local share totals Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council appropriates Forty Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) to the Torok Center ADA Renovations Account (Acct#232-7300-53633) from the unappropriated balance of the Federal Grant Fund, and Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to the Torok Center ADA Renovations Account (Acct #402-7300-53633) from the unappropriated balance of the Parks Capital Projects Fund, as the required match from the City to meet the terms of the Grant.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution was taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal action was in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
