A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL 2021 ENERGIZED COMMUNITY GRANT FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green (“Grantee”) is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (“NOPEC”) and is eligible for a NOPEC Energized Community Grant for 2021 (“NEC Grant”) as provided for in the NEC Grant Program Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, NOPEC, Inc. (“Grantor”) awarded Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$16,429.00) to the City of Green to be used primarily for energy efficiency or energy infrastructure projects in accordance with NOPEC Energized Community Grant criteria; and

WHEREAS, Grantor has endorsed the use of the NEC Grant funds by the Grantee to assist in the cost to install electric vehicle charging infrastructure at the Central Administration Building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc. accepting the 2021 NEC Grant in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$16,429.00); and
2. The Mayor agrees to obligate the NEC Grant funds to satisfactorily complete the electric vehicle charging infrastructure project proposed for the Central Administration Building at 1755 Town Park Boulevard, Green, Ohio.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the deadline can be met. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
