**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (“STBG”) FUND PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (“AMATS”) TO IMPROVE SEVERAL STREETS WITHIN THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green has identified four (4) different resurfacing projects within the City that it believes are eligible for funding through the Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (“STBG”) Program; and

WHEREAS, all of these Projects represent an important thoroughfare within the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvement to be performed, along with the estimated cost and the City of Green’s funding request for each Project are identified and described in Exhibit “A”, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor of Green to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (“STBG”) Funds, programmed by Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (“AMATS”) for the Projects identified and described in Exhibit “A”, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION TWO:**

The City of Green acknowledges and understands the AMATS “Funding Policy Guidelines” and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the Project Applications(s) will be accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue these projects, and that a local share will be required to match any federal funds.

**SECTION THREE:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FOUR:**

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green, and for the further reason that it is necessary to properly account for this donation on the City’s books and records. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4<sup>th</sup>) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
