In my opinion, the proposed "Raber Road Trail" is over-priced and won't likely achieve its objective of creating a new biking and walking trail.

I can't justify spending in the order of \$1M to install a separate paved path and move parts of Raber Road when completing the existing sidewalk would serve nearly the same purpose.

Raber road is a busy road, not likely safe for bicycles, and creating a path that runs parallel to it won't change the fact that once off the path, traffic is simply too heavy to support safe bicycling. The path itself won't be along a park or natural settling or be particularly scenic, so I can't see that it would be much of a draw for bicyclists. Its length would be too short for those seeking long rides.
